"Area Mail" is a service that sends disaster information to as many people as possible.



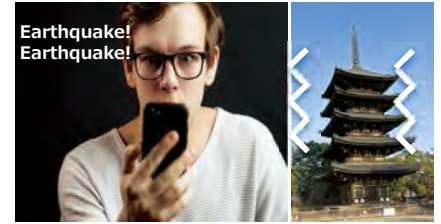
Area Mail is now available in multiple languages – to secure the safety of people in disaster-prone areas, by sending an emergency alert in multiple languages.

Japan Meteorological Agency (JMA) Area Mail

- The JMA Earthquake Early Warning and Tsunami Warning will be notified via voice and text in multiple languages: **English, Chinese, Korean, Spanish, and Portuguese.**
- **Available nationwide.**

(sample) "Go to ___ evacuation center."
"The ___ river is flooding!"

- Evacuation information issued by the municipal government is available in multiple languages: **English, Chinese, and Korean.**
- **Available in 99.9% of municipalities nationwide**
