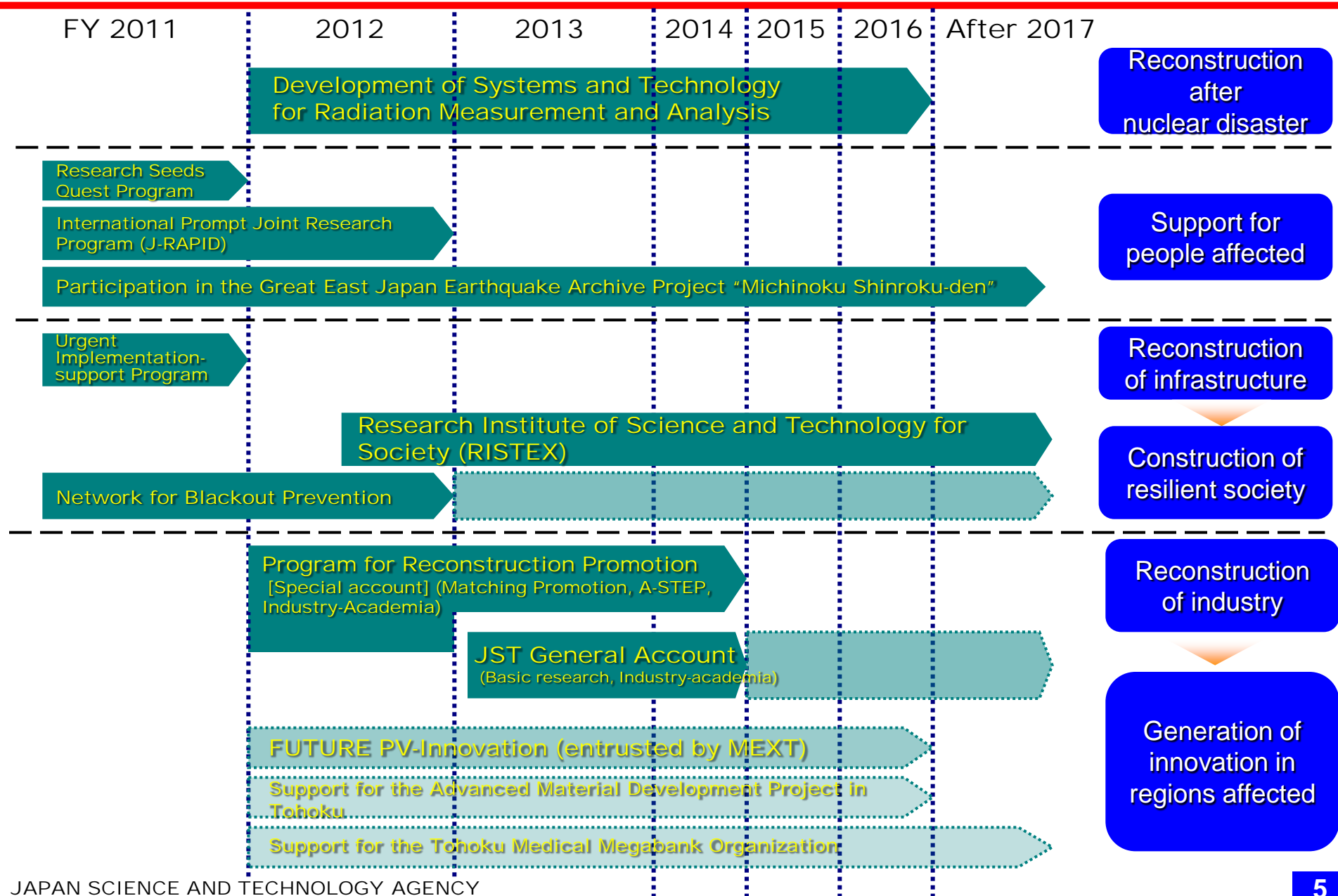

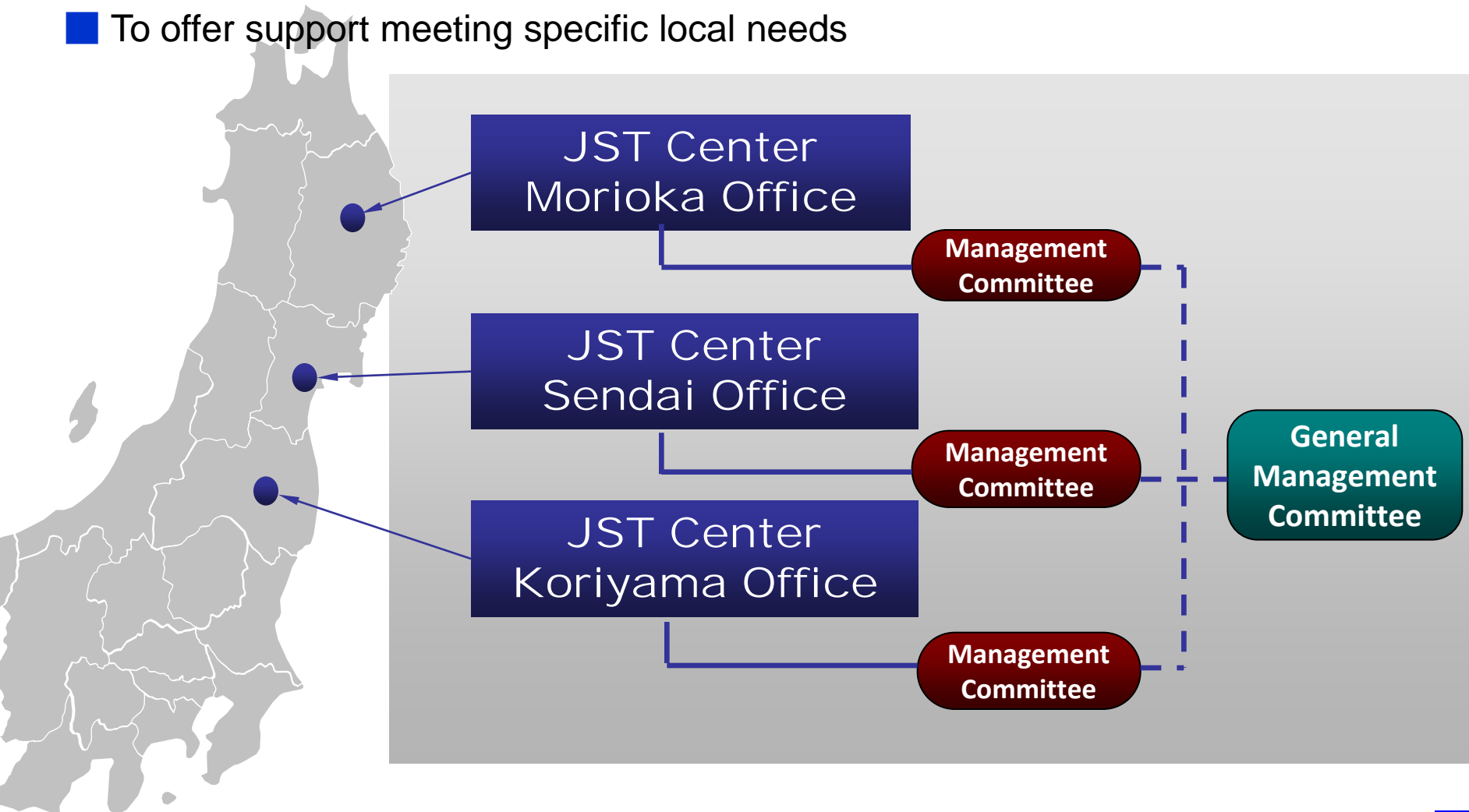
Reconstruction and Revitalization after the Earthquake
