## Biography

Li Zhidong is a professor at the Nagaoka University of Technology, Japan, and a visiting researcher at the Institute of Energy Economics, Japan (IEEJ), a visiting professor at the Energy Research Institute, National Development and Reform Commission, China (ERI/China). He graduated from the China People's University (Renmin University) in 1983 and received a PhD in Economics from Kyoto University, Japan, in 1990. He worked as a professional economist at the IEEJ from 1990 to 1995, mainly focusing on econometric analysis of the world energy outlook and world oil market modelling. He has been a major contributor to a joint Chinese–Japanese study project focusing on China's economy, energy and environment from 1999 to 2003. He is the author/co-author of a number of published books, as well as several articles published in academic and professional journals.
