Hiroshi Ohashi is associate professor at the Graduate School of Economics and the School of Public Policy, University of Tokyo. He has been an Affiliated Senior Fellow at the NISTEP, and a Faculty Fellow at the RIETI.

Professor Ohashi has published extensively in the areas of industrial organization, economics of innovation, and international trade with a particular emphasis on empirical aspects.
