## Biography

Hideaki Takeda is a Sumitomo endowed professor at Research into Artifacts, Center of Engineering (RACE) in the University of Tokyo. He is also a professor at National Institute of Informatics (NII) Japan, and the director of Research and Development Center for Scientific Information Resources in NII. He is also a professor at the Graduate University for Advanced Studies (Sokendai), and a designated professor at Research Institute for Sustainability Science (RISS) in Osaka University. He received his Ph.D. in precision machinery engineering from the University of Tokyo. He worked at Norwegian Institute of Technology and Nara Institute of Technology prior to joining these institutions. His research interests include information and knowledge sharing systems and design theory.
