Leila Takayama is an associate professor of Computational Media at the University of California, Santa Cruz, who studies Human-Robot Interaction. With a background in Cognitive Science, Psychology, and Human-Computer Interaction, Professor Takayama examines human encounters with increasingly autonomous technologies. She also does consulting for tech companies and non-profit organizations, helping them to make more data-driven decisions about how to design autonomous products and services.

Prior to UC Santa Cruz, she was a senior user experience researcher at GoogleX, and was a research scientist and area manager for human-robot interaction at Willow Garage. She has served as a World Economic Forum Global Futures Council Member and Young Global Leader. In 2015, she was presented the IEEE Robotics & Automation Society Early Career Award. In 2012, she was named a TR35 winner and one of the 100 most creative people in business by Fast Company.
