WG1: Expanding human potential for a society where everyone can pursue their dreams

By 2050, realization of a society in which human beings can be free from their limitations of body, brain, space, and time with harmonious empowerment.

WG2: Realizing a human life that "continues to improve both physically and psychologically" through complete understanding of biological functions

By 2050, realization of ultra-early disease prediction and intervention based on the Whole Body Network Atlas for longer, fuller and happier lives.

WG3: Expanding frontiers through co-evolution of AI and robots

By 2050, a robot can autonomously learn, adapt to the environment, evolve itself in intelligence and act with human beings.



WG4: Sustainable resources circulation for global environment

Realization of sustainable resources circulation to recover the global environment by 2050.

WG5: Innovation for future agriculture –satisfying both food production and environmental conservation

Creating a new food production system by 2050, which will enable both an "expansion of the amount of food supply" and "conservation of global environment".

WG6: Creating innovative non-traditional sciences and technologies based on quantum and related phenomena

Realize a fault-tolerant universal quantum computer that will revolutionize economy, industry, and security by 2050.

- Taking into account of the outcomes of the Moonshot International Symposium, CSTI will decide the Moonshot Goals.
- Funding Agencies will call for Project Managers (PMs)* and their proposals on Moonshot research from around the world.
- * Any nationalities are welcome to be PMs, but PMs are principally based in Japan upon assignment.
