JREC-IN Portal is operated by Japan Science and Technology Agency (JST). The degree of recognition of the website is quite high, especially among Ph.D.s.



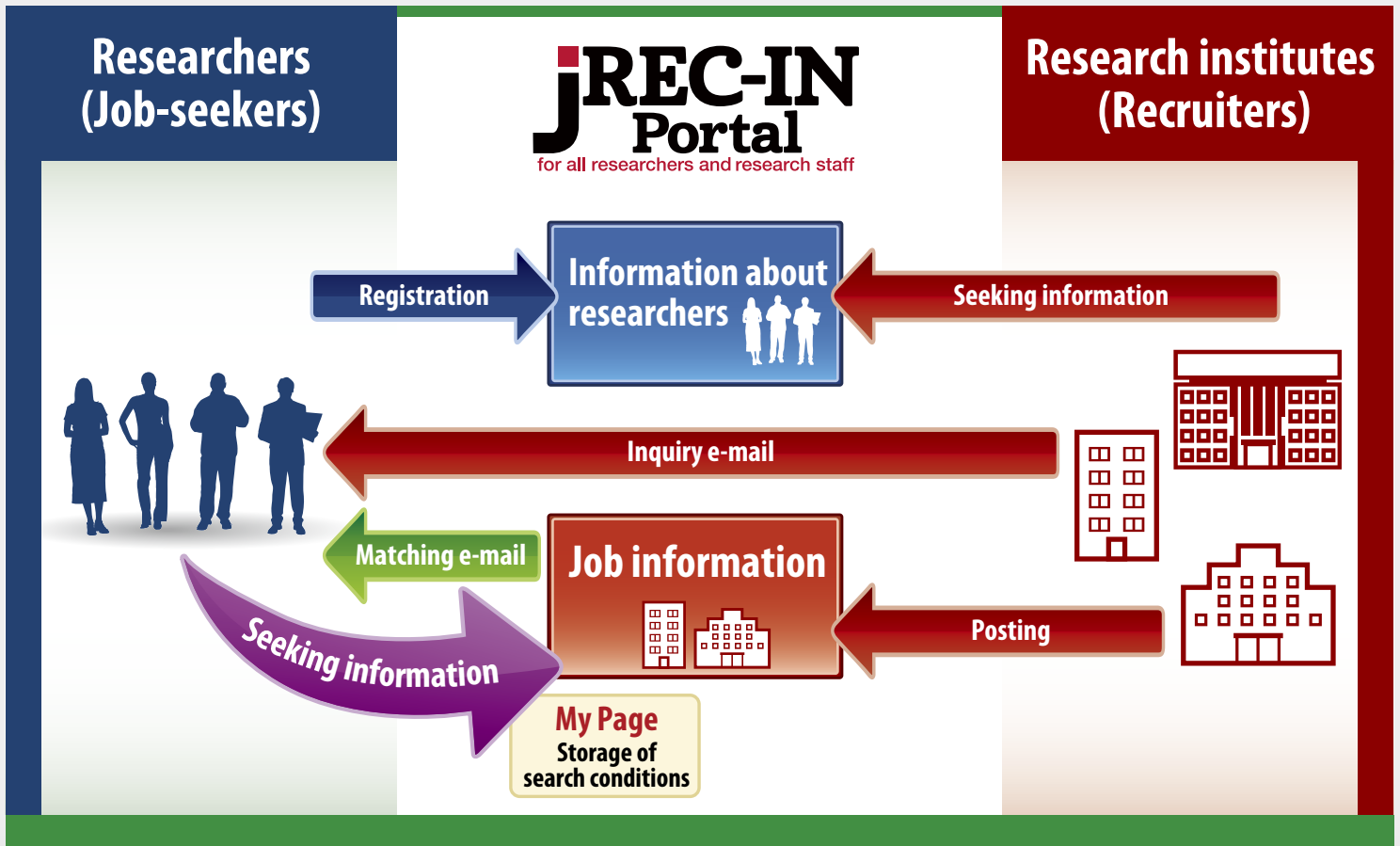
Free browsing, free membership registration, and free job posting

Services for Recruiting Members

- Posting job information: Information on job openings is sent to job-seeking members as Matching e-mails.
- Seeking researchers' information: CVs can be searched to find highly qualified candidates.
- Sending Inquiry e-mail: Inquiries can be sent to job-seeking members.
