## Mandatory Completion of Research Ethics Materials

<u>Researchers who are part of new projects funded by JST</u> are required to take a research ethics course through APRIN (eAPRIN) in order to prevent research misconduct (fabrication, falsification, plagiarism and misappropriation of public research funds).

## Features

- Students can take the course one module at a time, fully online. It is available 24 hours a day. Anytime, anywhere learning style.
- Prepared under the MEXT's Program for Promoting Inter-University Collaborative Education "Standardization of Code of Conduct Education and National Development of Educational Systems for the Development of Researchers" and the NPO Japan-US Medical Education Consortium, based on research and ethics materials used in the United States as a framework and in accordance with Japanese laws, guidelines and other matters.


