

Completion Report Number for the APRIN e-learning Program (eAPRIN)

If you have completed an e-learning course including the JST-designated modules through eAPRIN (formerly known as CITI), you will be able to obtain a Completion Report Number.

These are the valid Completion Report Number formats.

<Valid Completion Report Numbers>

Ref #xxxxxxx (7-8 digits) *1

JSxxxxxxxxxx (10 digits) *2

JBxxxxxxxxxx (10 digits) *2

JHxxxxxxxxxx (10 digits) *2

APxxxxxxxxxx (10 digits) *3

*1 Completion Report Number from the old system (CITI Japan).

*2 Completion Report Numbers for JST courses will include one of JS, JB, or JH. However, this is also the case if you setup and completed a JST course after registering through your institution.

*3 The Completion Report Number if you completed an original course through your institution on eAPRIN.

Any other number is not an eAPRIN Completion Report Number. For reference, the following are examples of an **invalid** Completion Report Numbers:

<Invalid Completion Report Numbers>

xxxxxxxARD (7 digits)

xxxx (a sequence other than 7 or 8 digits)

JSPSGxxxxx (contains letters other than those listed in the valid Completion Report Numbers above)
