

Professor Hidetoshi Fukuyama

Hidetoshi Fukuyama is professor emeritus of Tokyo University and is currently vice president of Tokyo University of Science. He received his B.S., M.S., and Ph.D. in physics from Tokyo University. He was director of the Institute of Solid State Physics, Tokyo University (1999-2003), director of the International Frontier Center for Advanced Materials of the Institute of Materials Research, Tohoku University (2004-2006). He is professor of Faculty of Science and director of Research Institute for Science and Technology(RIST) Tokyo University of Science, since 2006. His research interests are theoretical studies of quantum transport phenomena in solids in general, including orbital magnetism, spin-Peierls phenomena, Anderson localization, high-temperature superconductivity, and electronic properties of molecular solids.
